

Basic Obedience Classes for Dogs; *Canine Good Manners Class*

CLASS CURRICULUM

The *Canine Good Manners Class* will teach you how to extract good behaviors from your dog and how to eliminate the not so good behaviors. Dog parents will learn how to create well-mannered dogs in social settings and how to eliminate common problems such as jumping and mouthing. Dogs and dog parents alike will learn the fundamental cues: Sit, Down, Stay, Come, Watch Me, Go to Place, Leave It and Off! Sit/stays are practiced at doorways and in the presence of distractions. We also provide leash training to facilitate loose leash walking with your pet.



To provide the best experience for you and your pet, the basic obedience classes are limited to five pairs of parent/dog teams.

CLASS PARTICIPATION FEE

The fee for the class is \$135.00 per dog/parent team. This fee includes five (5), one-hour classes, all take-home educational material, and trainer consultations as needed.

VACCINATIONS

Pets must be current with their vaccinations including Bordetella. If your pet has not had the Bordetella vaccine, one must be administered at least 10 days prior to the start of class.

WHAT TO BRING TO CLASS

1. Flat buckle collar or harness and leash. Chain or prong collars are prohibited in the classroom, we'll teach you why.
2. Water bowl
3. Training treats for your pet

DOG PARENT OBLIGATIONS

To obtain the dog's maximum focus level, only one parent should attend class with their pet. Ideally, the same parent will attend all 5 classes but dog parents may alternate if desired. We regret that due to insurance restrictions, children under the age of 16 are not permitted in training classes.

We provide educational material and exercises to be utilized at home, in-between classes. To maximize the training process, we strongly recommend that parents work with their dogs at least twice a week in addition to attending class.

REFUNDS/CLASS SERIES SCHEDULE CHANGES

As classes are scheduled to accommodate only five parent/dog teams, we are unable to grant refunds. Should *Paws in Training* cancel or reschedule a class series, your registration fee will be refunded in full or transferred to another class at your discretion.
